1 Poors Land & Grass Cutting

Approval has been given to The P.T.A. for the November Fireworks display. The Football Club has put in a request for a grant towards the building of a storage facility for goal posts, and for toilets. It was thought that this was not possible at the moment in view of the cut backs.

2 Allotments
